"When I performed my first complete Handel opera, *Lotario*, those arias which looked so fiendish on the page felt not only comfortable, but just as if they had been written for me. I had the same very rare sensation while learning and performing my second complete Handel opera, *Partenope*, and that's when I noticed that both of them had been written for the same tenor - Annibale Pio Fabri.

Full of curiosity and enthusiasm, I started searching for other roles written for him. It was amazing to discover that all of these arias had similar characteristics, clearly made to highlight Fabri's vocal abilities, and that they all fit my voice like a glove. The fast ones with never-ending coloratura phrases, the slow ones full of feeling and lyricism, they all work well every time. This vocal comfort allows the music and the text to come alive and speak, as I can put my whole body and mind at their service. Having found all these fantastic arias, some of them never recorded or even performed since the 18th century, I feel it's my duty to bring them back to life."
